Providing Hope and Support: A Young Mother's Journey Towards Stability

A 27-year-old single mother of three toddlers has just begun her new employment as a pharmacy technician. She has not yet been paid but she anticipated receiving her income tax return allowing her to cover for some of her utilities expenses. Our Vincentians at **St. Thomas the Apostle** stepped in to lend a hand and guide our friend in need as she navigates through this new journey towards stability.

Despite her salary and benefits, she would still be about \$600 short each month. To help close this gap, our Vincentians contacted a local pregnancy assistance center for diapers and childcare products, reapplied to BVCAA for electric bill assistance, and referred her to local food pantries for groceries. During the Home Visit, our friend in need was provided with \$75 in toiletries and cleaning supplies from a Lenten Project by the CCE group at our parish and \$500 towards her \$578 electric bill using *UCP grant funds*. Vincentians then referred the 27 year old mother to the Getting Ahead program.


